2010 Earned Income Tax Credit Guidelines

Single / Head of Household	Max Income	Max Credit
0 Children	\$13,460	\$457
1 Child	\$35,535	\$3,050
2 Children	\$40,363	\$5,036
3 or More Children	\$43,352	\$5,666
Married / Filing Jointly	Max Income	Max Credit
0 Children	\$18,470	\$457
1 Child	\$40,545	\$3,050
2 Children	\$45,373	\$5,036
3 or More Children	\$48,362	\$5,666

1. Your investment income must be less than \$3,100 for the year.
2. You must be a U.S. Citizen or have been a resident alien for all of 2010.
3. Using the Earned Income Tax Credit does NOT necessarily affect your eligibility for TANF, Medicaid, Food Stamps, SSI or subsidized housing.

What To Bring With You:

- Proof of Identity (Picture I.D.)
- ALL W-2, 1098 or 1099 Forms
- Social Security Card or Tax ID Number (ITIN) card for all individuals listed on return
- Voided bank check or savings deposit slip (for direct deposit to receive refunds in 7-10 days!)
- Both spouses must present if filing jointly.
- Documentation of other income
- Vehicle sales tax receipt (if you or your spouse purchased a new vehicle in 2010)
- Childcare providers' ID number
- Verification of estimated tax payments made
